#### A BILL

#### Intituled

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) Ordinance, 1965.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1966.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) Ordinance, 1965, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title and commencement.

No. 7 of 1966.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1965.

2. Subsection (2) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "or Deputy Speaker" between the words "Speaker" and "of".

Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance.

3. The schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended by the addition thereto of the following:—

Amendment of schedule.

"10. The Deputy Speaker shall be paid a salary at the rate of \$4,200 per annum."

This Bill seeks to provide a salary of \$4,200 per annum for the person holding the office of Deputy Speaker of the House of Assembly.
