AN ORDINANCE to amend the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) Ordinance, 1965.

Enacted by the Lesislature of British Guiana :----

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Ministers, Members Short title of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments) (Amend- and comment) Ordinance, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices $_{No.7}$ of (Emoluments) Ordinance, 1965, hereinafter referred to as the Principal 1965.
