An Ordinance to amend the Medical Practitioners (Registration Ordinance, 1959.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Medical Practitioners (Registration) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Medical Practitioners (Registration) Ordinance, 1959, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "eighteen months" for the words "three years".

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend section 5 of the Medical Practitioners (Registration) Ordinance, 1959 to reduce to eighteen months the period of three years during which a person is now required to practise as a medical practitioner in any approved institution as a pre-requisite for registration as a medical practitioner in British Guiana under the provisions of Part III of the Colonial Medical Service Ordinance, Chapter 134.
