NEW AMSTERDAM TOWN COUNCIL (AMENDMENT)

A Bill

Intituled

An Act to amend The New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance to increase the borrowing powers of the Mayor and Town Council of New Amsterdam.

A. D. 1969 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.  
Cap. 161. 1. This Act may be cited as the New Amsterdam Town Council (Amendment) Act, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 196 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution of the words “one million five hundred” for the words “nine hundred and fifty” appearing in subsection (1) thereof;
- (b) by the substitution of the number “1,500,000” for the number “950,000” appearing in the marginal note thereto.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The borrowing powers of the New Amsterdam Town Council is statutorily limited to \$950,000. This Bill seeks to increase that amount to \$1,500,000.
