2. Amendment of section 3 of Chapter 61

AN ACT to amend the Public Holidays Ordinance.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Act, 1969, and shall be construed and read as if it were an Act with the Public Holidays Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and all amendments thereto.

2. Subsection (1) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects:—

- (a) by the deletion therefrom of the reference to Independence Day; and
- (b) by the insertion immediately after the words "the first week-day of January;" of the following words:—

"Republic Day, that is to say such day in each year as shall, by notice published in the Gazette, be appointed for the purpose by the Minister to whom responsibility for public holiday is assigned;"
