A BILL

Intituled

An Ordinance to amend the Tax Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1965

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment) **Short title.** Ordinance, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the **Principal Ordinance** Cap. 298. and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is Amendment of hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at section 5 of the end of the proviso and the addition thereto of the following the Principal proviso — Ordinance.

“Provided further that the duty chargeable as afore-said shall be remitted if the matches are taken out of bond or purchased for the use of Her Majesty’s Armed Forces stationed in British Guiana.”

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to provide for the exemption from excise duty payable on matches taken out of bond or purchased for the use of Her Majesty’s Forces stationed in British Guiana.
