## BUXTON SCHOLARSHIP (VALIDATION OF THE ACTS OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE TRUSTEES) BILL, 1965

### Arrangement of Sections.

#### Section

2. Validation of acts and indemnity.

### A BILL

#### Intituled

An Ordinance to validate the acts of the chairman of the trustees of the Buxton Scholarship Fund for the period commencing on the 11th November, 1955, and ending on the 10th November, 1964.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1965

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Buxton Scholarship (Validation of the Acts of the Chairman of the Trustees) Ordinance, 1965.

2. Notwithstanding any failure to comply with the requirements imposed by subsection (5) of section 3 of the Buxton Scholarship Ordinance to appoint a chairman of the trustees of the Buxton Scholarship Fund —

- (a) all acts done in good faith during the period commencing on the 11th November, 1955, and ending on the 10th November, 1964, by the person purporting to exercise the powers vested by law in the chairman of the trustees of the aforesaid Fund are hereby declared in all respects to have been validly, properly and lawfully done; and
- (b) the said person is hereby freed, acquitted, discharged and indemnified from all legal proceedings of any kind in respect of any such acts.

### OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to validate acts of the Chairman of the Trustees of the Buxton Scholarship Fund performed during the period commencing on the 11th November, 1955 and ending on the 10th November, 1964, during which no person was properly appointed as Chairman of the Trustees of the Fund.

2. It also seeks to indemnify the person who purported to act as Chairman during the said period.
