COMMISSIONER FOR COOPERATIVE DEVELOPMENT (VALIDATION OF ACTS) BILL, 1965

A BILL

Intituled

An Ordinance to confirm and validate all acts done in the purported exercise or performance of any right, power or duty as Commissioner for Cooperative Development by Mr. Clement Randolph Jarvis between the 1st July, 1964, and the 2nd March, 1965.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1965.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Commissioner for Co-operative Development (Validation of Acts) Ordinance, 1965. Short Title.
2. In this Ordinance — Interpretation.
“the Ordinance” means the Cooperative Societies Ordinance. Cap. 326.
3. Notwithstanding any failure to comply with the requirements imposed by section 3 of the Ordinance to appoint a person as Commissioner for Cooperative Development — Validation of certain acts.
 - (a) all rights, powers, acts and duties exercised or performed, or purported to be exercised or performed between the 1st July, 1964, and the 2nd March, 1965, in good faith by Clement Randolph Jarvis, Esquire, as Commissioner for Cooperative Development, under the provisions of the Ordinance, are hereby declared for all purposes to have been validly, properly and lawfully exercised or performed; and
 - (b) Clement Randolph Jarvis, Esquire, is hereby freed, acquitted, discharged and indemnified from all legal proceedings of any kind in respect of any such acts.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to validate the acts of Mr. C. R. Jarvis purported to have been performed as Commissioner for Cooperative Development between the 1st July, 1964, and the 2nd March, 1965, during which period no person was properly appointed as Commissioner for Cooperative Development.
