## Intituled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EXPORT OF TIMBER  
ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Export of Timber (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Export of Timber Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 29th October, 1951.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition after the word "declare" of the words "and the Governor in Council may vary or cancel any such notice by subsequent notice in the Gazette".

## OBJECTS AND REASONS

Section 3 of the Export of Timber Ordinance provides that the Ordinance shall apply to such timbers as the Governor in Council may by notice in the Gazette declare. From time to time it becomes desirable to alter the classes of timbers to which the Ordinance applies.

2. This Bill, therefore, seeks to confer upon the Governor in Council the power to cancel or vary any such notice. The Bill also seeks to validate previous action taken by the Governor in Council in that behalf.
