AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE RENT RESTRICTION
ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rent Restriction (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be construed and read as one with the Rent Restriction Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 186.

2. Subsection (4) of section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, without prejudice, however, to anything done in pursuance of the said subsection prior to the enactment of this Ordinance.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

By repealing the subsection referred to above, the bill abolishes the right of landlords to charge fines and premiums in respect of leases for a term of five years or upwards.
