AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BAKERIES (HOURS OF WORK) ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bakeries (Hours of Work) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be construed and read as one with the Bakeries (Hours of Work) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 120.

2. The following section is hereby inserted immediately after section 11 of the Principal Ordinance—

Insertion of new section 12 in Chapter 120.

"Meaning of term 'employment'.

12. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) of this section, the term 'employment' shall be deemed for the purposes of this Ordinance to include work being carried on by a person on his own account, and the term 'employed' shall be construed accordingly.

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to section 7 of this Ordinance."

OBJECTS AND REASONS

When section 3 of the Bakeries (Hours of Work) Ordinance, 1946 (No. 4) was amended by the Bakeries (Hours of Work) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, (No. 23) to include persons who manufacture bread or flour confectionery on their own account, no consequential amendments were made.

This bill seeks to remedy the defect.
