AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE SUPREME COURT ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supreme Court (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Supreme Court Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance, as substituted by section 2 of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "six" in subsection (1) thereof of the word "seven".

Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance, as substituted by section 3 of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "twelve" and the words "sixty thousand" in subsection (1) thereof of the word "fourteen" and the words "sixty-nine thousand six hundred" respectively.
