AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE UNDESIRABLE PUBLICATIONS (PROHIBITION OF IMPORTATION) ORDINANCE, 1953.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Undesirable Publications (Prohibition of Importation) (Repeal) Ordinance, 1953.

2. The Undesirable Publications (Prohibition of Importation) Ordinance, 1953, is hereby wholly repealed.

3. Any acts declared to be valid by section 7 of the said Undesirable Publications (Prohibition of Importation) Ordinance are now declared never to have been validated.

Read three times and passed by the House of Assembly on the twenty-fourth day of July, one thousand, nine hundred and fifty-three.
