A BILL

INTITULED

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SPECIAL PROVISION IN REGARD TO THE PENSION AND GRATUITY PAYABLE TO EDWARD ARDEN CARTER.

ENACTED by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Edward Arden Carter Pension Ordinance, 1954. Short title.
2. Anything to the contrary contained in any Ordinance notwithstanding, the pension payable to Edward Arden Carter shall be, and is hereby declared to be, at the rate of four hundred and sixty-one dollars and eighty cents per annum and the gratuity payable to the said Edward Arden Carter shall be, and is hereby declared to be, the sum of one thousand five hundred and thirty-nine dollars and thirty cents. Payment of special pension and gratuity to E. A. Carter.
3. Save as in this Ordinance provided the provisions of the Militia Band Ordinance shall apply to the pension payable to the said Edward Arden Carter as though the said pension were computed under the aforesaid Ordinance. Pension to be subject to the provisions of the Militia Band Ordinance, Cap. 29.
4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st November, 1944. Commencement

OBJECTS AND REASONS

The objects of this Bill are to make special provision in regard to the pension and gratuity payable to Edward Arden Carter, retired Band Sergeant-Major of the British Guiana Militia Band.
