AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SPECIAL PROVISION IN REGARD TO THE PENSION AND GRATUITY PAYABLE TO EDWARD ARDEN CARTER.

ENACTED by the Legislature of British Guiana: -

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Edward Arden Carter Short title. Pension Ordinance, 1954.

2. Anything to the contrary contained in any Ordinance Payment of notwithstanding, the pension payable to Edward Arden Carter special shall be, and is hereby declared to be, at the rate of four hundred pension and sixty-one dollars and eighty cents per annum and the gratuity ity to E. A. payable to the said Edward Arden Carter shall be, and is hereby Carter. declared to be, the sum of one thousand five hundred and thirtynine dollars and thirty cents.

3. Save as in this Ordinance provided the provisions of the Pension to Militia Band Ordinance shall apply to the pension payable to the said Edward Arden Carter as though the said pension were computed under the aforesaid Ordinance.
