The University of Guyana Bill, 1963, originally published in the *Gazette* on the 2nd of March, 1963, was passed by the Senate on the 18th of March, 1963, with the undermentioned amendments.

The Bill which will be considered by the Legislative Assembly is published for general information with the amendments incorporated.

AMENDMENTS

- Clause 3* — (i) *Deleted* — The word “The” from the phrase “The University of Guyana” in the second line.
- (ii) *Substituted* — The words “movable and immovable” for the words “real and personal” in the penultimate line.
- Clause 8* — *Substituted* — The word “may” for the word “shall” in the first line.
- Clause 9* — (i) *Deleted* — Subsection (2).
- (ii) *Substituted* — The following as subsection (2):
“(2) A person appointed Chancellor shall hold office for the period expressed in his instrument of appointment and shall be eligible for re-appointment.”
- (iii) *Inserted* — The following as subsection (3):
“(3) The first Chancellor shall be Edgar Mortimer Duke, Esquire, C.B.E., LL.B.”
- Clause 12* — (i) *Deleted* — Paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) of subsection (2).
- (ii) *Substituted* — The following for paragraphs (b), (c) and (d) of subsection (2):
“(b) not more than two persons to be nominated by the Academic Board when it shall have been constituted;
(c) not more than two persons to be nominated by the Guild of Graduates when it shall have been constituted; and
(d) not more than ten persons appointed by the Council of Ministers.”

- (iii) *Inserted* — The words and commas “ , unless re-appointed,” between the words “case” and “shall” in the third line of subsection (3).
- (iv) *Substituted* — The word and letters “(b), (c) and (d)” for the word and letters “(b) and (c)” in the second line of subsection (6).
- (v) *Substituted* — The word “any” for the word “either” in the last line of subsection (6).
- Clause 16* — *Inserted* — The word “of” between the words “Guild” and “Graduates” in the last line.
- Clause 17* — (i) *Inserted* — The comma and words “ , rights and duties” immediately after the word “powers” in the third line.
- (ii) *Inserted* — The words “or to be affiliated to” between the words “affiliate” and “other” in the first line of paragraph (i).

A BILL

Intituled

An Ordinance to provide for the establishment and incorporation of the University of Guyana and for matters connected therewith.

A.D. 1963 Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the University of Guyana Ordinance, 1963.

Interpretation 2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires —
 “Chancellor” means the Chancellor of the University;
 “Principal and Vice Chancellor”, and “Bursar” respectively mean the Principal and Vice Chancellor, and Bursar of the University;
 “Board of Governors” and “Academic Board” respectively mean the Board of Governors and Academic Board of the University;
 “Statutes” means Statutes made under this Ordinance;
 “University” means the University of Guyana.

Incorporation. 3. There shall be and there is hereby constituted and founded a University by the name and style of “University of Guyana” by which name the Chancellor, Principal and Vice Chancellor and all other persons who are for the time being members of the University
