# A BILL Intituled

# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE AUCTIONEERS ORDINANCE

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Auctioneers (Amend-Short Titlement) Ordinance, 1962, and shall be construed and read with the Auctioneers Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordi-Cap. 349. nance and any Ordinance amending the same.
- 2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "two per centum" of the words "three of Sec. 6 of Cap. 349.

  Amendment of Sec. 6 of Cap. 349.
- 3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st day of January, 1962.

#### **OBJECTS AND REASONS**

Under Section 6 of the Auctioneers Ordinance, Chapter 349, on the sale of property at auction, auction duties at the rates of two per centum and one per centum of the gross amount of the sale are payable by the purchaser and seller respectively.

2. The Bill seeks to raise the rate payable by the purchaser from two per centum to three per centum and by the seller from one per centum to two per centum.
