A BILL

Intituled

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Local Government Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 150.

2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor —

Amendment of section 3 of Cap. 150.

“(b) the officer for the time being performing the duties of the Director of Medical Services, or in his absence from any meeting of the Board, or of a Committee of the Board, an officer of the Medical Department duly authorised in writing by the Director of Medical Services;”

OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to enable the Director of Medical Services to authorise in writing an officer of his Department to take his place as a member of the Local Government Board at any meeting of the Board or of any Committee of the Board when he is himself unable to attend.
