AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EAST DEMERARA WATER  
CONSERVANCY ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the East Demerara Water Conservancy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the East Demerara Water Conservancy Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same. Short title.  
Cap. 236.

2. Paragraph (g) of section 51 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of a comma for the full-stop at the end thereof, and by the insertion thereafter of the words "or that a plantation be deleted from either schedule." Amendment

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend paragraph (g) of section 51 of the East Demerara Water Conservancy Ordinance (Chapter 236) to empower the Governor in Council to direct, by order, that a plantation be deleted from either schedule.
