**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ADOPTION OF CHILDREN  
ORDINANCE, 1955.**

Enacted the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Adoption of Children (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Adoption of Children Ordinance, 1955, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 21 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

**OBJECTS AND REASONS**

The Secretary of State has advised that section 21 of the Adoption of Children Ordinance 1955, is of no effect as it seeks to add to the categories of persons who may be made citizens of the United Kingdom and Colonies, and that the section should therefore be repealed.

Clause 2 of this Bill seeks to repeal section 21 of the said Ordinance.
