**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSA-
TION ORDINANCE WITH RESPECT TO THE APPLICA-
TION OF ITS PROVISIONS TO DOMESTIC SERVANTS.**

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same. Short title.
Cap. 111.

2. The proviso to subsection (1) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (f) thereof, and by the renumbering of paragraphs (g) and (h) as paragraphs (f) and (g) respectively. Amendment

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such day as the Governor may by Proclamation appoint. Commence-
ment.

OBJECTIONS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to remove the exemption of domestic servants from the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Ordinance.
