AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE DEEDS REGISTRY
ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Deeds Registry Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Subsection (4) of section 17 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "by the Registrar in person" of the words "only by the Registrar or by the Deputy Registrar".

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

It is considered desirable that the Deputy Registrar of Deeds should have the authority to perform the duties in connection with transports and mortgages which are at the present time performed only by the Registrar. This bill seeks to achieve that purpose.
