RULES OF COURT

Made Under

THE HIGH COURT ACT

(Cap. 3:02)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON IT BY SECTION 67 OF THE HIGH COURT ACT, THE RULES COMMITTEE HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING RULES OF COURT:—

1. These Rules, which amend the Rules of the High Court*, ^{Citation.} may be cited as the Rules of the High Court (Amendment) Rules 1987.

2. Order 7 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by ^{Amendment of Order 7 of the Principal Rules.} the substitution for rule 7 of the following rule —

^{“No service on certain days.”} 7. Service of a writ of summons shall not be made on any public holiday or on any Saturday.”.

3. Rule 1 of Order 48 of the Principal Rules is hereby ^{Amendment of Order 48 of the Principal Rules.} amended by the substitution for paragraph (4) of the following paragraph —

“(4) where any limited time less than six days from or after any event is appointed or allowed for doing any act or taking any proceeding, any public holiday or any Saturday shall not be reckoned in the computation of such limited time;”.
