INSTRUMENT APPOINTING A PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY

By the President of the Co-operative

WHEREAS it is provided by article 113(1) of the Constitution that the President may appoint Parliamentary Secretaries to assist himself or Ministers in the discharge of their functions:

AND WHEREAS it is provided by article 183(1) of the Constitution that Parliamentary Secretaries may be appointed from among persons who are elected members of the National Assembly or are qualified to be elected as such members;

AND WHEREAS CDE. LEROY EVANS SCOTLAND, is qualified to be elected as a member of the National Assembly;

NOW, THEREFORE, acting under the aforementioned provisions I do hereby appoint the said CDE. LEROY EVANS SCOTLAND, to be a Parliamentary Secretary with effect from 1st June, 1987 and designate "Parliamentary Secretary, in the Office of the Prime Minister" as the style by which he shall be known in the office of Parliamentary Secretary.
