IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE RULES COMMITTEE BY SECTION 67 OF THE HIGH COURT ACT, THE SAID RULES COMMITTEE DO HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING RULES OF COURT:—

These Rules, which amend the Rules of the High Court, <sup>Citation and commencement</sup> may be cited as the Rules of the High Court (Amendment) Rules, 1986, and shall come into operation on 1st June, 1986.

2. Order 7 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by the <sup>Amendment of Order 7 of the Principal Rules.</sup> substitution for rule 7 of the following rule —  
“No service on certain holidays. 7. Service of a writ of summons shall not be made on a Saturday, Sunday, Good Friday or Christmas Day.”

3. Order 12 rule 3 (1) of the Principal Rules is hereby amended <sup>Amendment of Order 12 of the Principal Rules.</sup> by the substitution for the words “eleven o'clock in the forenoon of the day (not being a public holiday)” of the word “2.30 o'clock in the afternoon of the day (not being a Saturday or a public holiday)”.

4. Order 48 of the Principal Rules is  
following respects —

- (a) in rule 1 (4), by the insertion after the words "Whit Tuesday,"  
of the words "Saturday,";
- (b) in rule 6, by the substitution for the portion beginning  
with the words "four in the afternoon" and ending  
with the words "following Monday" of the following  
words —

"4.30 in the afternoon on Mondays to Thursdays, or  
on Fridays after the hour of 3.30 in the afternoon  
shall, for the purpose of computing any period of  
time subsequent to such delivery or service, be  
deemed to have been effected on the following day,  
or in the case of Fridays, on the following Monday."

Amendment  
of Order 57  
of the  
Principal  
Rules.

5. Order 57 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "3 o'clock in the afternoon and on Saturday between 8.00 o'clock and 11.00 o'clock in the forenoon" of the words "3.30 o'clock in the afternoon from Mondays to Thursdays and on Fridays between 8.30 o'clock in the forenoon and 2.30 o'clock in the afternoon."
