**INSTRUMENT APPOINTING A PERSON TO ACT
AS DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC PROSECUTIONS**

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (2) of article 203 of the Constitution of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana that if the holder of the office of Director of Public Prosecutions is for any reason unable to perform the functions thereof, the President, acting, in accordance with the advice of the Public Service Commission tendered after the Commission has consulted the Prime Minister, may appoint a person to act in the office of Director of Public Prosecutions.

AND WHEREAS the person holding the office of Director of Public Prosecutions will be proceeding on twenty-four weeks' long vacation leave from the 1st November, 1984, and for the reason will be unable to perform the functions of the said office;

NOW THEREFORE, acting under the aforementioned provision and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling me in that behalf I do hereby appoint:

CDE GEORGE HORACE ROY JACKMAN

to act in the office of Director of Public Prosecutions with effect from the 1st November, 1984, until further notice.
