IN PURSUANCE OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 75 OF THE HIGH COURT ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING US IN THAT BEHALF, WE, EDWARD VICTOR LUCKHOO, CHANCELLOR, HAROLD BRODIE SMITH BOLLERS, CHIEF JUSTICE, VICTOR EMANUEL CRANE, JUSTICE OF APPEAL, KENNETH MONTAGUE GEORGE, PUISNE JUDGE, KENNETH WYNDHAM BARNWELL, REGISTRAR OF THE SUPREME COURT, JOSEPH OSCAR FITZCLARENCE HAYNES, SENIOR COUNSEL, AND MAURICE ERIC CLARKE, SOLICITOR, CONSTITUTING THE RULES COMMITTEE UNDER THE SAID SECTION 75, DO HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING RULES:—

1. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Rules of the High Court, 1970, and amend the Rules of the High Court, 1955, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules.

(2) These Rules shall come into operation forthwith.

2. Order 57 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended in the following respects:—

(a) by the substitution of the number “3” for “3.30”.

(b) by the insertion immediately after “8.00 o’clock” of “and 11.00 o’clock”. and

(c) by the deletion of “and 12.00 o’clock noon”.
