THE DEEDS REGISTRY ORDINANCE
(Chapter 32)

IN PURSUANCE OF RULE 8 OF THE DEEDS REGISTRY RULES AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING US IN THAT BEHALF, WE, EDWARD VICTOR LUCKHOO, CHANCELLOR; HAROLD BRODIE SMITH BOLLERS, CHIEF JUSTICE, VICTOR EMANUEL CRANE, JUSTICE OF APPEAL, KENNETH MONTAGUE GEORGE, PUISNE JUDGE, KENNETH WYNDHAM BARNWELL, REGISTRAR OF THE SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE, JOSEPH OSCAR FITZCLARENCE HAYNES, SENIOR COUNSEL, AND MAURICE ERIC CLARKE, SOLICITOR, CONSTITUTING THE RULES COMMITTEE UNDER SECTION 75 OF THE HIGH COURT ORDINANCE, DO HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING RULES —

1. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Rules of the High Court (Deeds Registry) (No. 2) 1970, and amend the Rules of the High Court (Deeds Registry) hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules.

(2) These Rules shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 21st day of November, 1970.

2. Rule 2 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended in the following respects:—

(a) by renumbering paragraphs (1) and (2) as paragraphs (2) and (3) respectively.

(b) by inserting the following paragraph as paragraph (1) —

“An opponent may enter opposition in the registry by filing a notice thereof, in the form, and containing the particulars and requirements given, in the schedule hereto.”
