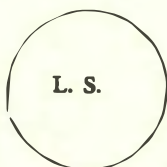

INSTRUMENT APPOINTING A MINISTER



By His Excellency SIR DAVID JAMES GARDINER ROSE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Guyana.

WHEREAS it is provided by Article 34(4) of the Constitution of Guyana that the Ministers other than the Prime Minister shall be appointed by the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, from among persons who are elected members of the Assembly or are qualified to be elected as such members, provided that the number of Ministers holding office at any time who are not elected members of the Assembly and were not elected members at the time of their appointment shall not exceed four;

AND WHEREAS Martin Wylde Carter is not an elected member of the Assembly but is qualified to be elected as such a member:

NOW, THEREFORE, acting under the aforementioned provisions and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby appoint the said Martin Wylde Carter, Esquire, to be a Minister with effect from 6th June, 1967.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of Guyana at Guyana House Georgetown, Guyana, this 5th day of June, 1967, and in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
