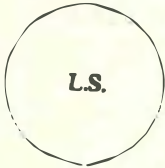

INSTRUMENT APPOINTING A PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of article 43 of the Constitution of Guyana that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may appoint Parliamentary Secretaries from among the members of the National Assembly to assist Ministers in the discharge of their functions;

AND WHEREAS Oscar Eleazar Clarke, Esquire, M.P., was on 9th February, 1965, appointed a Parliamentary Secretary to assist the Minister of Education, Youth, Race Relations and Community Development in the discharge of the responsibilities assigned to her in pursuance of article 33 of the Constitution of British Guiana:

NOW THEREFORE in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (1) of article 43 aforesaid and by virtue and in exercise of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby revoke the said appointment and appoint the said Oscar Eleazar Clarke, Esquire, M.P., to be a Parliamentary Secretary to assist the Prime Minister in the discharge of the responsibilities assigned to him in pursuance of article 36 of the Constitution of Guyana with effect from the 13th day of October, 1967.
