

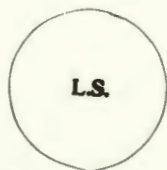

**INSTRUMENT AUTHORISING A MEMBER OF THE CABINET TO
PERFORM FUNCTIONS CONFERRED ON THE PRIME MINISTER**

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of Article 38 of the Con-
stitution of Guyana that whenever the Prime Minister is absent from Guyana
or is unable by reason of illness to perform his functions as Prime Minister,
the Governor-General may authorise some other member of the Cabinet to
perform those functions (other than the functions conferred by the said Article
38) and that member may perform those functions until his authority is revoked
by the Governor-General:

AND WHEREAS the Prime Minister will be absent from Guyana from
Saturday 25th October, 1969:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the said provisions, and in accordance
with the advice of the Prime Minister, I do hereby authorise Dr. the Honourable
Ptolemy Alexander Reid, M.P., Minister of Finance, to perform the functions
conferred on the Prime Minister by the said Constitution (other than the func-
tions conferred on him by the said Article) with effect from the 25th October,
1969.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of Guyana
at Guyana House, Georgetown, Guyana, this 24th
day of October, 1969, and in the eighteenth year
of Her Majesty's Reign.
