ALTERATION OF COMMISSION APPOINTING INQUIRY AS TO WHETHER THE EMPLOYERS IN THE TIMBER INDUSTRY CAN, IN RELATION TO THEIR EMPLOYEES, AFFORD TO IMPLEMENT THE MINIMUM WAGE RATES RECENTLY INTRODUCED IN RESPECT OF PERSONS EMPLOYED IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 2 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, Chapter 19:03, that the President may issue a Commission appointing one or more Commissioners and authorising such Commissioner or Commissioners to inquire into any matter in which an inquiry would, in the opinion of the President, be for the public welfare;

AND WHEREAS being of the opinion that it would be for the public welfare that an Inquiry should be held to determine whether the employers in the Timber and Quarry Industries can, in relation to their employees, afford to implement the minimum wages rates recently introduced in respect of persons employed in the public service I, by instruments made under my hand of the eighth day of December, 1977 and the fifteenth day of February, 1978 appointed a Commission of Inquiry for the purpose;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 3 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act that in case any Commissioner shall be or become unable or unwilling to act or shall die, the President may appoint another Commissioner in his place;

AND WHEREAS it appears that with respect to an inquiry into the Quarry Industry PETER WILLEMS is unable to act;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the aforesaid provision and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I do by this Commission appoint and authorise —
