# A BILL

## Intituled

- AN ACT to amend the Summary Jurisdiction (Petty Debt) Act to extend the civil jurisdiction of Magistrates' Courts.
- A.D. 2009 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Administration of Justice Act 2009.

Amendment of the Summary Jurisdiction (Petty Debt) Act. Cap. 7:01 2. Sections 3 and 4 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Petty Debt) Act are amended by the substitution for the words "fifty thousand" wherever those words appear, of the words "one hundred thousand". +

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to increase the limitation of the jurisdiction of a Magistrate's Court. At present a Magistrate may hear a civil matter involving a sum of fifty thousand dollars. This sum is now increased to one hundred thousand dollars.
