Short title.

1. This Act, which amends the Bills of Sale Act, may be cited as the Bills of Sale (Amendment) Act 2009.

Amendment of
section 9 of
the Principal
Act.

2. Section 9 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by the substitution for it of the following subsection -

“(1) The registration of a bill of sale, whether executed before or after the commencement of this Act, shall be renewed once at least every three years, and if a period of three years elapses from the registration or renewed registration of a bill of sale without a renewal or further renewal (as the case may be), the registration shall become void.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Bill of Sale Act (Cap. 90:12) to remove the requirement for annual renewal of bills of sale and substitute the requirement of renewal every three years.
