**SECTION**

1. Short title.
2. Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised.
3. Appropriation.



**A BILL**  
**Intituled**

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the fiscal year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2010, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of those sums for the specified purposes, in the conformity with the Constitution.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2 for 2010) Act 2010.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized.

No. 20 of 2003.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the gross of six billion, eight hundred and sixty-one million, nine hundred and seventy-six thousand, two hundred dollars (\$6,861,976,200), necessary to meet the expenditure of Guyana for the fiscal year ending on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2010, is hereby authorized in accordance with article 219 of the Constitution and sections 24 and 41 of the Fiscal Management and Accountability Act 2003.

Appropriation Schedule.

3. Every sum set out in the Schedule is hereby appropriated for the purposes specified therein with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2010.
