ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title and commencement.
2. Amendment of section 36A of the Principal Act.

A Bill

Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Local Authorities (Elections) Act to provide for the postponement of elections of councillors of a local democratic organ.

A.D. 1998 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title and commencement. Cap. 28:03

1. This Act, which amends the Local Authorities (Elections) Act, may be cited as the Local Authorities (Elections) (Amendment) Act 1998, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st August, 1997.

Amendment of section 36A of the Principal Act.

2. Section 36A(1) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "ten months" of the words "twenty-four months".

This Bill seeks to extend the date on which local government elections may be held.
