AN ACT to amend the Mahaica-Mahaicony-Abary Agricultural Development Authority Act.

1. This Act which amends the Mahaica-Mahaicony-Abary Agricultural Development Authority Act 1977, may be cited as the Mahaica-Mahaicony-Abary Agricultural Development Authority (Amendment) Act 1998.

2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Act is hereby amended in the following respects —

(i) by the substitution for paragraph 1 (1) of the following —

“1. (1) The Authority shall consist of the following persons as members who shall be appointed by the Minister —

- (a) the Chairman, provided that where no Chairman is appointed the Minister shall be the Chairman;
- (b) the Deputy Chairman;
- (c) the General Manager of the Authority;
- (d) a person representing the interest of local government in the area, designated by the Minister assigned responsibility for local government;
- (e) a representative designated by the Drainage and Irrigation Board;
- (f) one workers' representative;
- (g) a representative designated by the National Dairy Development Programme;

- (h) four persons who in the opinion of the Minister are representative of farmers;
- (ii) in paragraph 3(3), by the substitution for the words "nine members" of the words "five members".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to reconstitute the Mahaica-Mahaicony-Abary Agricultural Development Authority so that it may discharge its functions with greater efficiency.
