#### Intituled

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum neces ary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the financial year ending 31st December, 1980, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of that sum for pecified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

A.D. 1980 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

**Short** title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1980.

The Accountant General, may on the warrant of the Minister, Issue from 2. the Consoli-dated Fund issue from the Consolidated Fund a um not exceeding in the aggre-authorised. gate the gro s amount of seven hundred and eventy-one million, four gate the gro s amount of seven hundred and eventy-one million, four hundred and fifty-seven thou and, seven hundred and forty-three dollars (\$771,457,743) for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government and for other purposes for the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1980, and before that date the appropriate accounting officers shall pay in to the Accountant General for deposit into the Consolidated Fund, the ums totalling eight million, four hundred and sixty four thousand, nine hundred and eighty seven dollars (\$8,464,987) shown as appropriation -in-aid in the last column of the schedule, thereby making the issue from the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure for the financial year, not exceeding in the aggregate the net sum of seven hundred and sixty-two million, nine hundred and ninety-two thouand, seven hundred and fifty-six dollars (\$762,992,756).

Appropriation. 3. The net um granted in section 2 is hereby appropriated for the services and purpo es expressed in the schedule pursuant to and in accordance with article 1 + 1 (2) of the Constitution with effect from 1st January, 1980.
