AN ACT to amend the Interpretation and General Clauses Act.

Short title.
Cap. 2:01

1. This Act, which amends the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, may be cited as the Interpretation and General Clauses (Amendment) Act 1986.

2. Section 27 of the Principal Act is hereby amended in the following respects —

(a) in subsection (3), by the substitution for the word “Nothing”, of the words “Subject to the provisions of subsection (3A), nothing”;

(b) by the insertion, after subsection (3), of the following subsection as subsection (3A) —

“(3A) The President may delegate a Minister or a Parliamentary Secretary to make subsidiary legislation or to hear any appeal on his behalf.”;

(c) by the substitution, in subsection (4) for the words “or a Minister” of the words”, a Minister or a Parliamentary Secretary”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend section 27 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, Cap. 2:01, so as to authorise the President to delegate a Minister or Parliamentary Secretary to make subsidiary legislation or to hear any appeal on his behalf and to include in the definition of “public officer” in subsection (4) of that section a Parliamentary Secretary.
