APPROPRIATION ACT 1989

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

Section

1. Short title.
2. Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised.
3. Appropriation.

SCHEDULE

A BILL

INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the financial year ending 31st December, 1989, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of that sum for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

A.D, 1989 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1989.

Issue from
the Consol-
dated Fund
authorised.

2. The Accountant General, may on the warrant of the Minister, issue from the Consolidated Fund a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the gross amount of fifty one hundred and thirty one million, eight hundred and eleven thousand dollars (\$5,131,811,000) for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government and for other purposes for the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1989, and before that date the appropriate accounting officer shall pay to the Accountant General for deposit into the Consolidated Fund, the sum totalling two million, nine hundred and ninety-nine thousand dollars (\$2,999,000) shown as appropriation-in-aid in the last column of the Schedule, thereby making the issues from the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure for the financial year, not exceeding in the aggregate the net sum of fifty one hundred and twenty-eight million, eight hundred and twelve thousand dollars (\$5,128,812,000).

Appropriation.

3. The net sum granted in section 2 is hereby appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule pursuant to and in accordance with Article 218(2) of the Constitution with effect from 1st January, 1989.

- (a) The net sum granted; and
- (b) sum which may be applied as appropriation-in-aid in addition thereto, to defray the charges of the several Heads and Divisions of Expenditure herein particularly mentioned which will come in course of payment during the year ending 31st December, 1989.
