1. This Act, which amends the Post and Telegraph Act, may be cited as the Post and Telegraph (Amendment) Act 1990.

2. Section 27 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion after the word “conditions”, of the words “(including the payment of fees)”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend section 27 of the Post and Telegraph Act, Cap. 47:01, to allow the Post Office to charge fees where any person is authorised to collect and deliver letters or other postal packages otherwise than by post.
