CINEMATOGRAPH (AMENDMENT) BILL 1983

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Cinematograph Act.

A.D. 1983

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.  
Cap. 21:02

1 This Act, which amends the Cinematograph Act, may be cited as the Cinematograph (Amendment) Act 1983.

2. Section 11 of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the substitution in subsection (2), for the words “The district commissioner or assistant district commissioner”, of the words “the chairman of the regional democratic council of the region where the premises are situated or his representative, the regional executive officer of that council or his representative”;
- (b) by the insertion of the following subsection immediately after subsection (2) as subsection (2A) —
  - (2A) In subsection (2) “chairman of the local authority” does not include the chairman of the regional democratic council, but includes where the local authority is a rural authority the agent appointed under section 21 (4) of the Local Government Act

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

The Bill seeks to amend section 11(2) of the Cinematograph Act, Cap. 21:02, so as to make the Chairman of a Regional Democratic Council, and the Regional Executive Officer, or their representatives, members of a Board constituted under that provision, in the place of the District Commissioner or Assistant District Commissioner. The Bill also seeks to clarify that in the case of a Board for a rural district, the member representing the local authority shall be an agent appointed by the Minister since the local authority under the Local Government Act Cap. 28:02, for a rural district is the Minister.
