# DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1970

### A BILL

### Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Drainage and Irrigation Ordinance.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Brainage and Irrigation (Amendment) Act, 1970, and shall be construed and read as one with the Brainage and Irrigation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- Short title

- 2.(1) Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects —
  - (a) by the substitution of the following paragraph for paragraph (a) -
    - "(a) the Chief Works and Hydraulics
      Officer, the Chief Agricultural
      Officer or in his absence from
      any meeting of the Board of of
      any committee thereof, the Beputy
      Chief Agricultural Officer, the
      Permanent Secretary in the Ministry
      responsible for the administration
      of the Local Government Department
      or in his absence from any meeting
      of the Board or any committee
      thereof, the Principal Assistant
      Secretary in that Ministry(hersing
      after referred to as "ex officio
      members");";
      - (b) by the substitution of the ing paragraph for paragraph

- (c) by the insertion of the words "or such greater number as may be fixed by the Minister" immediately before the word "shall" in subsection (6).
- (2) Anything lawfully done under the Principal Ordenance prior to its amendment by paragraph (b) of subsection (1), and which would continue to have effect but for such amendment, shall continue to have effect as if so done in conformity with such amendment.

### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Section 4(1) of the Brainage and Irrigation Ordinance (Chapter 192) provides for the holder of the former office of Commissioner of Local Government to be a member of the Brainage and Irrigation Board. With the abolition of the office of the Commissioner of Local Government, it is necessary to amend the Ordinance to provide for another public officer to be a member of the Board in his stead. This Bill therefore saeks to provide for the Permanent Secretary in the Ministry of Local Government (or in his absence the Principal Assistant Secretary) to be a member of the Board in place of the former Commissioner of Local Government.

2. This **Bill** also seeks to provide for the Beputy Chief Agricultural Officer to attend meetings of the Board in the absence of the Chief Agricultural Officer and for flexibility in the number of members of the Board to be appointed by the Minister under section 4(1)(d) of the Ordinance.
