An Act to amend the Mariners' Club (Georgetown) Ordinance.

A.D. 1970 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Mariners' Club
Cap. 202 (Georgetown)(Amendment) Act, 1970 and amends the Mariners' Club (Georgetown) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to, the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment of the Principal Ordinance. 2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects -

(a) by the substitution of the words "such period not exceeding three years as shall be specified in the instrument by which he is appointed" for the words "three years from the date of his appointment" in subsection (3) of section 4; and

(b) by the substitution of the word "Minister" for the words "Governor", "Chief Secretary" and "Financial Secretary" wherever they occur, otherwise than in section 6.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Mariners' Club (Georgetown) Ordinance (Chapter 202) to enable trustees to be appointed for any period not exceeding three years. Under the existing Ordinance, trustees must be appointed for a period of three years. The Bill also seeks to vest in the Minister the responsibility for the Mariners' Club and the powers now exercisable by the
