AN ACT to amend the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957.

A.D. 1970. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Repeal of section 3 of the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Ordinance 1957. No. 27 of 1957. Cap. 32.

4. Section 3 of the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, is hereby repealed, and the Deeds Registry Rules (contained in the second schedule to the Deeds Registry Ordinance) shall have effect as if the said section 3 had never been enacted.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, in order that the time for entering opposition to the passing of a transport, mortgage or lease can be prescribed by Rules of Court as was done prior to amendment of the Deeds Registry (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957. It is considered that it is more convenient for the time to be fixed by Rules of Court.
