The Federal Supreme Court (Appeals) Ordinance, 1958, as adapted and modified by the Guyana Independence (Adaptation and Modification of Laws) (Judicature) Order, 1966, in relation to the Court of Appeal shall have effect as if the word "five" were substituted for the word "three" in section 36(1).
