LAND REGISTRY (VALIDATION OF AWARDS) BILL, 1972

2. Validation of certain awards.

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to validate certain awards of titles purported to have been made under the Land Registry Ordinance, 1959.

A. D. 1972 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana.—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Land Registry (Validation of Awards) Act, 1972.

Validation of certain awards, No. 18 of 1959. No. 47 of 1972. 2. Anything to the contrary contained in the Land Registry Ordinance 1959 notwithstanding, all awards of title purported to have been made thereunder by a Commissioner of Title in respect of the lands situated in the area described in the schedule to the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Demerara River) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order 1972 shall, with effect from the respective dates of those awards, be deemed for all purposes to be valid and effectual in law as though the awards were made in compliance with the provisions of the said Ordinance.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The awards of title to the land situated in the area described in the Schedule to the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Demerara River) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order 1972 were not made in strict compliance with the provisions of the Land Registry Ordinance 1959. This Bill therefore seeks to regularise the awards of those titles.
