"(4) Nothing in subsection (2) or (3) shall affect any proceedings in relation to the liability for the payment of rates or the recovery thereof, determined before the enactment of this Act.".

<u>Clause 25</u> was then <u>passed</u> as <u>amended.</u>

<u>Clause 26</u> was <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.

The <u>Schedule</u> was <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.
