# ITEM 4 TIMBER MARKETING BILL 1973 - Bill No. 28/1973 published 11.12.73

The Minister of Energy and Natural Resources moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL OF THE SALE AND USE OF TIMBER AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH. The Deputy Speaker spoke to the motion.

Thereafter the Minister of Energy and Natural Resources replied.

The motion was then put and carried.

The Bill was read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

## In Committee

<u>Clause 1</u> was <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.

<u>Clause 2</u> was <u>passed</u> with the following corrections:

- (i) <u>Substitution</u> of the word "or" for the word "of" immediately after the word "treatment" in the second line of the definition of "approved preservative treatment".
- (ii) Substitution of the words "any one" for the word "anyone" and the word "erecting" for the word "erection" in the definition of "building operation".

<u>Clauses 3 to 14 were passed</u> as printed.

Clause 15 was passed with the following correction:

Insertion of the word "be" immediately after the word
"may" in the last line of subsection (2).

Clause 16 was passed as printed.

Clause 17 was passed with the following correction:

<u>Substitution</u> of the words "to the owner without prejudice to the owner" for the words "penalty than is provided by this Act" in the last line.

Clauses 18 and 19 were passed as printed.

<u>Clause 20:</u> The following amendment by the Deputy Speaker was put and <u>carried:</u>

Deletion of the words "hammer or" in paragraph (d).

<u>Clause 20</u> was then <u>passed</u> as <u>amended</u>.

Clause 21 was passed as printed.

<u>Clause 22</u> was <u>passed</u> with the following correction:

<u>Substitution</u> of the word "or" for the word "on" in the second line of subsection (2).

Clauses 23 and 24 were passed as printed.

<u>Clause 25</u> was <u>passed</u> with the following correction:

<u>Insertion</u> of the word "time" immediately before the word "of" in the last line of subsection (2).

<u>Clauses 26 to 29</u> were <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.

Assembly resumed.

Ln a motion by the Minister of Energy and Natural Resources, the Bill was read the third time and <u>passed</u> as <u>amended</u> in Committee.
