## ITEM 3 SUGAR LEVY BILL 1974 - Bill No. 20/1974 published 20.6.74

In accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified Cabinet's recommendation and moved the second reading of the following Bill:

> A BILL intituled AN ACT TO IMPOSE A LEVY ON SUGAR MANUFACTURED IN GUYANA AND EXPORTED THEREFROM AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER MATTERS INCIDENTAL THERETO.

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE SUGAR INDUSTRY SPECIAL FUNDS ACT.
